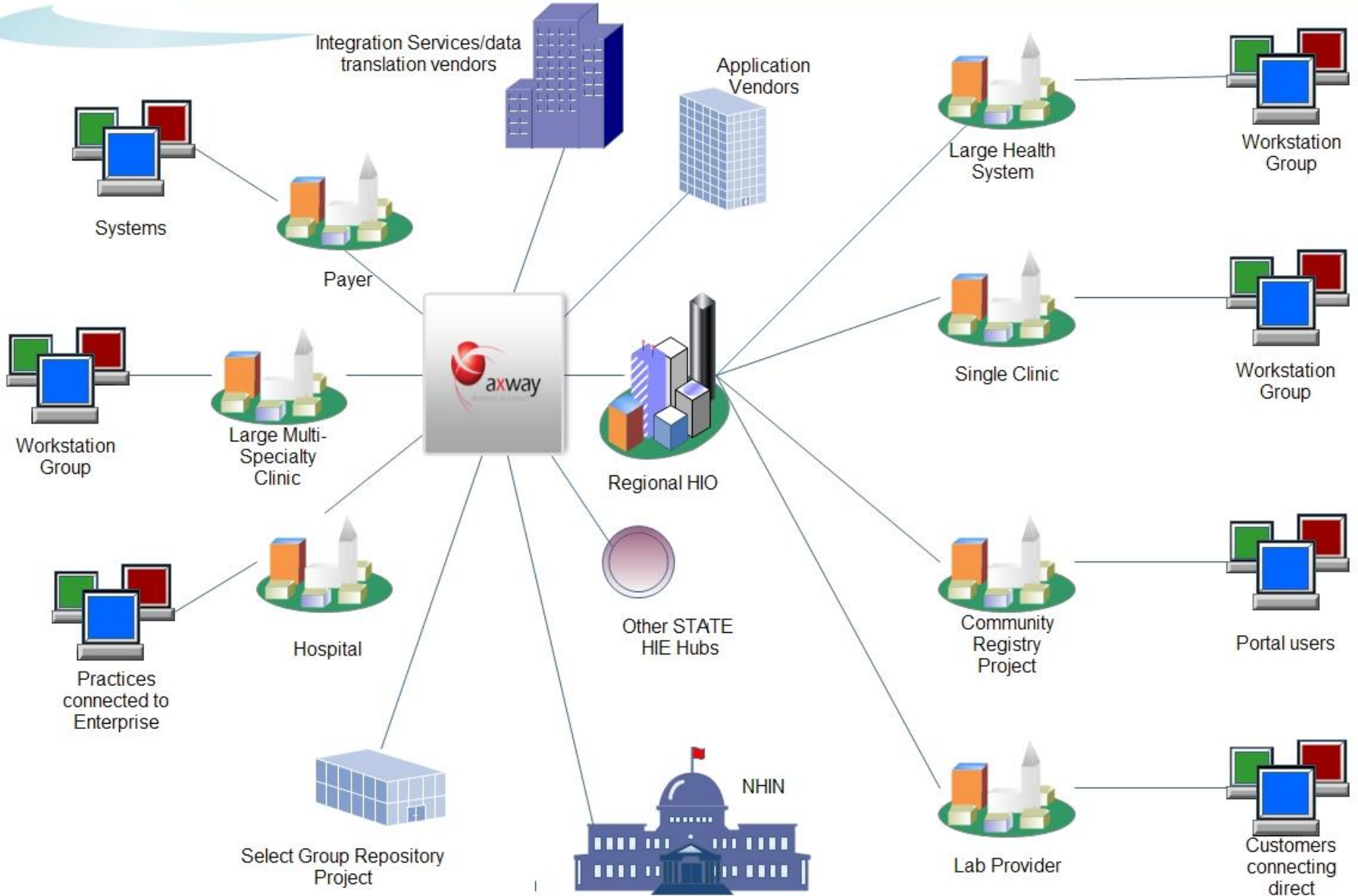


What Does an HIE Look Like

Why Join an HIE

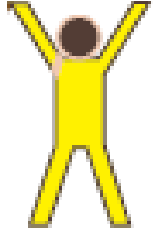
- Simplify connectivity to a growing number of trading partners
- Help meet Meaningful Use requirements if going for MU subsidies.
- Connect to Accountable Care Organizations (ACO) for utilization reporting
- Connect to CMS for Quality reporting
- Connect to State registries for query and reporting

Use Cases for the HIE

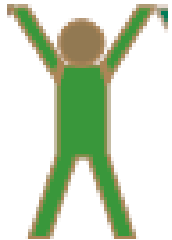
- To help organizations understand how the HIE can be utilized by any organization, the HIE has USE CASE stories about main transactions:
 - Electronic prescribing
 - Eligibility verifications
 - Lab and radiology results
 - Continuity of Care Document – patient record
 - Immunization reporting and checking
 - ADT – discharge summaries/pt demographics

Dr. Kant



Dr. Able



- Dr. Kant – May not have an EMR but does want to trade data electronically
- Dr. Able – Has systems and is interested in doing as much electronically as possible



Who are the Characters?

Character	Systems	Wants to Send	Wants to Receive
Dr. Kant	does not have an EMR	Transcription, forms	lab reports and CCD via web browser
Dr. Able	has a qualified EMR & practice system (PMS)	eRx, CCD, forms, Immunizations	CCD, eRX, Immunizations, ADT, Eligibility
My Neighborhood Pharmacy	has a real-time pharmacy system	eRX, Med history, immunizations	eRx, CCD, Lab results, immun.
Northwest Lab	Several	Lab results	Lab orders, ADT, eligibility
Images Anywhere	Several	Rad results, images	CCD, orders, eligibility
General Hospital	Several	ADT, Lab, Rad	CCD, eligibility
My Health Plan	Several	Eligibility, med history	ADT, CCD
Public Agency	Several	Immunizations, reportable labs	Immunizations, ADT, CCD, Labs

Community Pricing

- Community oversight group approves pricing and policies
- Annual Subscription – no transaction fees – self select level
- All trading partner subscription levels are published for transparency
- Early adopter perks

Organization Level	Organization Description – SAMPLE Metrics	2011 Annual Subscription
Entry	Smallest orgs: revenue <\$10M, 1-9 practitioners	\$600
Small	Revenue \$10M - \$100M, 10-50 practitioners, <50 beds	\$6,000
Mid-size	Revenue \$100M - \$500M, 50+ practitioners, 50 – 500 Beds	\$12,000
Large	Revenue \$500M - \$1B, <500K insured lives, 500+ Beds	\$24,000
Leadership	Largest orgs: revenue \$1B+, 500K+ insured lives, 3,000+ FTE	\$48,000
